Immunogen

Peptide with sequence C-NYRRTDHEDPRVK, from the internal region of the protein sequence according to NP_003604.2.

Purification and Storage

Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin.

Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.

Applications Tested

Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1:128000.

Western blot: Approx 150kDa band observed in rat spinal cord lysates (calculated MW of 133kDa according to human NP_003604.2 and of 132kDa according to Rat NP_001101631.1). Recommended concentration: 0.1-0.3µg/ml.

Species Reactivity

Tested: Rat

Expected from sequence similarity: Human, Mouse, Rat, Dog

EB07350 (0.03 μ g/ml) staining of rat spinal cord lysate (35 μ g protein in RIPA buffer). Primary incubation was 1 hour. Detected by chemiluminescence.
