Immunogen

Peptide with sequence C-QASPSRDSSTDLTQ, from the internal region of the protein sequence according to NP_003122.1.

Purification and Storage

Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin.

Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.

Applications Tested

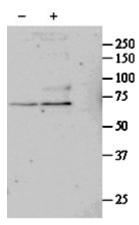
Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1:32000.

Western blot: Approx 67kDa band observed in primary cultured Human Lung fibroblasts lysates after 24 h treatment with 1ng/ml TGF-bl (calculated MW of 51.6kDa according to NP_003122.1). The observed molecular weight corresponds to earlier findings in literature with different antibodies (Davis FJ et al, Am J Physiol Heart Circ Physiol. 2002 Apr;282(4):H1521-33.; PMID: 11893590). Recommended concentration: 1-3μg/ml.

Species Reactivity

Expected from sequence similarity: Human, Mouse, Dog, Cow
