Important Comments: No cross-reaction expected with STAM1.

Immunogen

Peptide with sequence C-QSIDPTDSKPDSQD, from the internal region of the protein sequence according to NP_005834.3.

Please note the peptide is available for sale.

Purification and Storage

Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin

Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.

Applications Tested

Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1:8000.

Western blot: Approx 70kDa band observed in Human Spleen lysates (calculated MW of 58.2kDa according to NP_005834.3). The observed molecular weight corresponds to earlier findings in literature with different antibodies (Pandey et al J Biol Chem. 2000 Dec 8;275(49):38633-9; PMID: 10993906). Recommended concentration: 1-3µg/ml.

EB07213 ($1\mu g/ml$) staining of Human Spleen lysate ($35\mu g$ protein in RIPA buffer). Primary incubation was 1 hour. Detected by chemiluminescence.
